The parties agree to collaborate in accordance with the Norms and Standards of NCTE/UGC/Affiliating Body under the following terms:

1. Purpose

Objective of the MoU.

The primary purpose of this MoU is to establish a framework for collaboration between the two colleges in areas related to NCTE regulated courses, Higher Education (HE) Courses, and other mutually agreed academic activities, strictly for the educational benefit of students.

Terms and Conditions.

Point 1: Compliance with NCTE Regulations

Both colleges confirm that they have carefully read, understood and accepted all the rules and regulation prescribed by the National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE), Both parties declare that there are no doubts, disputes or misunderstandings regarding NCTE guidelines applicable to their respective institutions.

Point 2 : Purpose of the Agreement:

This MoU is being executed solely for the purpose of academic cooperation and to ensure mutual educational benefits for both institutions. The Collaboration will aim to enhance teaching quality, student development and institutional growth.

Point 3: Student-Centric Collaboration :

Under this agreement, Both colleges shall work together for the benefits of students by –

- Sharing academic resources, information, and best practices.
- Extending mutual support in academic and administrative matters.
- Providing equal opportunities for students of both colleges where applicable.

Point 4 : Support for NCTE and HE Courses. :

The College conducting NCTE approved Courses and the college offering Higher Education (HE) courses shall mutually assist each other as per the applicable regulations.

Both institutions agree to :

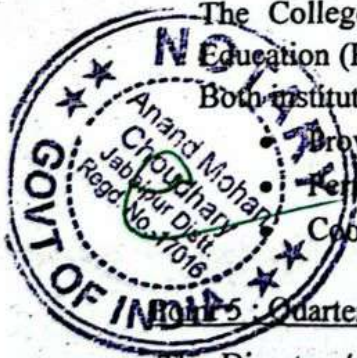
- Provide necessary academic and infrastructural support when required.

Point 6: Sharing of Infrastructure and facilities :

In accordance with this MoU, both colleges agree to share their available infrastructure and facilities within their respective premises for students academic benefits, including but not limited to :

- Classrooms,
- Laboratories,
- Libraries,
- Play grounds and sports facilities
- Any other mutually agreed facilities.

This sharing will strictly comply with NCTE regulation and will be course related only.

Point 7 : Scope of the MoU :

This MoU is specifically applicable to course governed by NCTE and Higher Education authorities.

It will not apply to any other programs , courses, or activities conducted under the same society unless expressly agreed upon by both parties in writing.

Point 8 : Validity and Extension of Agreement:

The MoU shall remain in force for a period of 10 Years from the date of signing.

If both parties mutually agree, the duration of the MoU may be extended through a written amendment signed by the authorized representatives of both colleges.

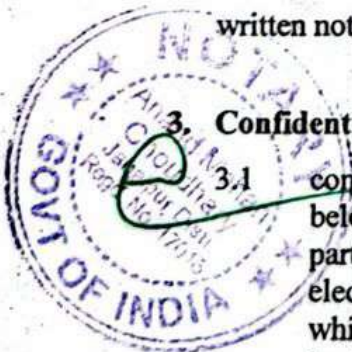
General Terms:

1. Good Faith Cooperation – Both Colleges agree to maintain transparency, mutual trust, and professional ethics in all activities under this MoU.
2. Non- Transferability – This MoU is non-transferable and cannot be assigned to any third party without prior written consent.
3. Dispute Resolution – Any disputes arising out of this agreement shall be resolved amicably through mutual discussions. If unresolved, the matter shall be referred to the Governing Body of Shiv Narayan Foundation Jabalpur and Mahakaushal Shiksha Prasar Samiti Jabalpur for final decision.
4. Termination Clause – Either party may terminate the MoU by providing 60 days written notice to the other party, subject to the approval by the society.

3. Confidentiality

- 3.1 confidential information shall mean any proprietary information, date or facts belonging to PARTIES collectively or severally , disclosed by the disclosing party under this MoC or any subsequent MoC, whether in writing, verbal or electronically, irrespective of the medium in which such information is stored, which is marked confidential or with any other words having similar meaning by the parties, or declared or identified so by the disclosing party before such disclosure or during the discussions. However, confidential information shall not include any date of information which:

- a) is or becomes publicly available through no fault of the receiving party.

such data or information.

- c) is independently developed by the receiving party without reference to the confidential information of the disclosing party.
- d) is rightfully obtained by the receiving party from a third party or is in the public domain.
- e) is disclosed with the written consent of the party whose information it is, or
- f) is disclosed pursuant to court order or other legal compulsion, after providing prior notice to the disclosing party.

3.2 During the tenure of the MoC both the parties will maintain strict confidentiality and prevent disclosure of all the information and data exchanged under the scope of this MoC for any purpose other than in accordance with this MoC.

3.3 Both the parties shall bind their respective personnel who come into possession or knowledge of any confidential information not to disclose the same to third parties without written approval of the disclosing party or use such confidential information for any use other than intended under this MoC.

3.4 Further, both the parties shall put in place adequate and reasonable measures to keep and store confidential information secure so as to prevent any unauthorized use.

4. **Duration and Termination**

Total duration of the MoC shall be 10 years from the date of the sanctioning of the MoC by 15/09/2025 any extension, modification or termination of the MoC shall be subject to mutual consent of the parties.

5. **Dispute Resolution**

This MoC shall be governed by the laws applicable in the State/UT where the collaborating institutions are registered. Any disputes arising out of or in connection with this MoC shall be first resolved amicably through mutual consultation. If unresolved, they shall be referred to arbitration under the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 (as amended). The language of arbitration will be English.

Governing Law

This MoC shall be subject to the jurisdiction of courts at Jabalpur (M.P.)
